ArcSDE 9.1 Upgrade This Weekend!

Beginning June 8

The sangis data warehouse server and our internal landbase maintenance server (vulcan) will both be updated to ArcSDE version 9.1 this weekend.

Since ESRI support is not available on the weekends, we will be starting these upgrades TONIGHT.

Please refrain from using the sangis server after 5:00 PM on Thursday, June 8.

We anticipate that sangis will be available on Friday as usual. If there are problems, we will notify you.

You must upgrade your client software (ArcView, ArcEditor, ArcInfo) to 9.1 to be able to access the sangis database once the update is completed. If you have not yet upgraded your workstation to 9.1, the time is now!

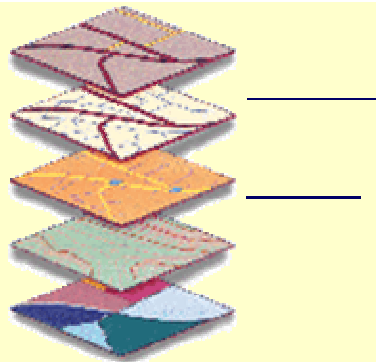
Distribution list is important

More importantly, it will cause those users to miss important announcements regarding emergencies resulting in server downtime, etc.

SanGIS has chosen to use this web-based service called Constant Contact for communication. This service takes requests for removal very seriously and will not allow us to re-add your email to the distribution list once you have requested removal.

Still Awaiting Delivery

Eagle has had a few system problems that have delayed the delivery of the new imagery. We hope to receive it any day. After the dust settles from our upgrade to ArcSDE version 9.1, we hope to start loading the new imagery into SDE. You will be notified before this process starts as we will need to remove the old imagery first to make space for the new. We will start delivering the Mr. Sid compressed imagery DVDs as soon as the product arrives.

It is important to note that although the SanGIS data distribution policy changed, Eagle Aerial imagery is a licensed product and may **not** be distributed beyond County and City departments. As with the 2005 delivery, each user will need to sign a license agreement showing he/she understands the limitations of use. The DVDs and license agreements will be available from your GIS Manager.
