Eagle Imagery on DVD

Mr. Sid Formats

The Eagle imagery has been delivered and compressed into two MrSid versions, generation 2 and generation 3. The gen3 version is the newest version and should work on any current version of ESRI software. There are a total of 4 gen3 sid files and each one is stored on a DVD. The countywide set includes 4 DVDs: Northwest, Northeast, Southwest and Southeast.

A gen2 version was also created in order to support older applications. This is the format that we distributed previously. The gen2 format has a file size limit, causing more files to be created. Last year there were a total of 9 sid files for about half the county. To avoid creating numerous files this year, we used a larger compression ratio. There are a total of 6 gen2 sid files and they are stored on 2 DVDs.

Both the gen2 and gen3 versions are now available from SanGIS. These DVDs may be used both for desktop applications and in the field through our license agreement with Eagle. **The imagery can not be distributed externally.** You are required to sign an acknowledgement of the terms of use prior to receiving this product.

Eagle Imagery on sangis

We will begin loading the new Eagle imagery into SDE/Oracle on Wednesday, August 16. As previously discussed, **due to disk space limitations we will need to delete the current Eagle imagery** that only covers the metro area prior to loading the new imagery. **Please be aware that that 2004 imagery will no longer be available for online access through SDE starting Tuesday night (August 15).**

Our past experience with loading imagery has prepared us for several things to go wrong...but we remain hopeful that the 9.1 version of ArcSDE has improved loading processes. We hope to have the new imagery available by next week. We will send a broadcast message when it is available through SDE.

Thanks for your patience with this delivery. We hope you find the new online and DVD products helpful in your work.

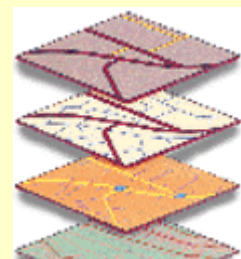
